Wellbeing at Nossal High School

At Nossal High School acknowledges that student wellbeing and student learning outcomes are intrinsically linked and aim to promote a culture where all members of the community recognise the significant role, they have in contributing to an individual's wellbeing. We have a clearly defined Wellbeing Structure which is supported by a team of people. This includes

- Tutorial teachers who spend time every morning with students. They also spend time with them during the Nossal Time (Pastoral care program)
- **Heads of House** who have an overview of members of the house.
- Counselling Team our counselling team consists of a Mental Health Practitioner who is a psychologist, counsellors and even a Therapy(Wellbeing) dog - Mya.

The team collaborates closely to ensure that we meet wellbeing needs of everyone in our community. We also aim to build resilience through a large number of proactive programs.





The Wellbeing Team -

There are a range of strategies that are applied to nurture students' wellbeing and sense of connectedness to school. Some things that we do


- Create a culture that is inclusive, engaging and supportive. We aim to embrace and celebrate diversity and empower all students to participate and feel valued.
- Monitor student attendance our aim is to keep students connected to the school.
- We engage in school wide support such as Respectful Relationships and safe school's programs.
- For individual students we have specific strategies that are applied on a case-by-case basis. These include Student Support Groups, Individual Education Plans, Student Support Services and external supports such as council-based youth and family service.

We encourage parents to *share any medical and wellbeing information* with us, it really helps us understand your student and best support them while at school. We assist with things like second-hand uniform, travel passes and other issues.

Traffic Safety

Nossal High School is accessed via Sir Gustav Nossal Boulevard, a gazetted public road with a speed limit of **20kph**. To ensure the safety of the Nossal Community and other groups within the precinct, please ensure that all traffic signage and speed limits are always obeyed. Failure to comply with road rules may result in penalties under the Road Safety Act.



A **Shared Zone** is identified through signage and a raised paved area. There are 3 shared zones along Sir Gustav Nossal Boulevard with a speed limit of **10kph**. Please be aware that pedestrians have right of way.



Please remember when approaching the roundabout to reduce speed. You must give way to any vehicle already in the roundabout.


Traffic Safety

When dropping off and picking up students please ensure you do not impede the flow of traffic-

- Ensure you have moved to the side of the road
- Do not obstruct emergency parking bay or accessible parking bays
- Do not obstruct school buses
- Obey No Standing signage and directional signage


Demystifying PFA
